If you develop COVID symptoms on the 17th or 18th December and receive a positive test on any of the above days, please inform school via head@greatellingham.norfolk.sch.uk so we can inform relevant bubbles. If you receive a positive test after Christmas, the school does not need to be informed until the first day of term (Monday 4th January 2021).

This is in-line with new guidance from the government stating that we need to identify close contacts within 6 days of school finishing over the holidays.
